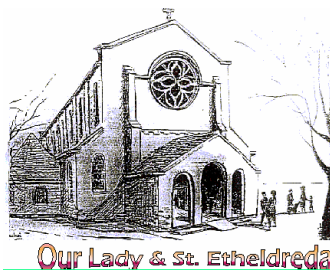

GIFT AID

Gift Aid donations are providing a much valued and very important source of income for the Parish in that it receives tax refunds in respect of donations made. It is essential however that donors should be paying Income Tax in an amount equal to the claim made by the Diocese in respect of each donor.

It is being assumed at present that unless the Parish Gift Aid co-ordinators are informed to the contrary, claims for tax refunds will continue to be made in the coming tax year in respect of Gift Aid donations made by Newmarket and Kirtling donors.

Any queries or notifications should be addressed **ONLY** to the co-ordinators **Laurette Burton** for Newmarket and **Peter Walmsley** for Kirtling.

Please note also that weekly cash Gift Aid donations **MUST** be given in the official envelopes supplied by the Church or donations may be made by cheque or standing order. Any "home made" envelopes with cash are not allowed to be accepted for claims to HM Revenue & Customs.

All gift aid arrangements are confidential - many thanks to all those who have signed up for Gift Aid— if you are a tax payer and haven't signed a Gift Aid form we'd love to hear from you!
