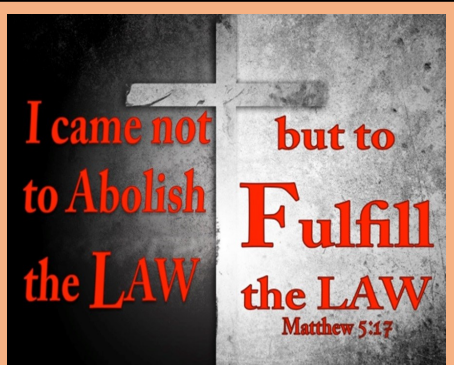

Inviting all young people in Year 9 and above to 'Flame' at Wembley Arena.

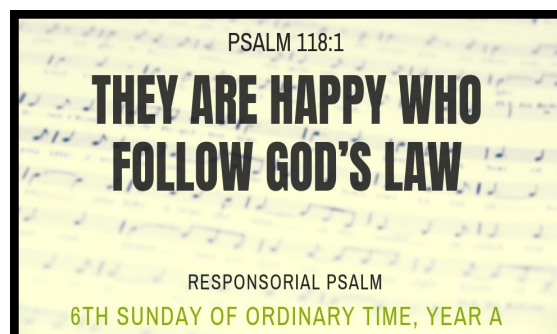
