Many thanks to those who supported the initiatives over the Christmas period volunteering their time to help those in need in our parish of all faiths and none. We hosted a hundred people for lunch on Christmas Day, brilliantly organised by Tina Walker who was supported by many parishioners and friends from Churches Together in Newmarket (CTND) The SVP hosted eleven families, who would have received free school meals if not on holiday, for play and fed over forty with homecooked hot food. Six parishioners and others from CTND have been working on Thursday mornings all year to run the foodbank that helps up to seventy people each week. Both our music groups combined to sing carols with CTND outside the library in the Guineas Shopping Centre, and many smaller kindnesses were performed in God's name.
