Ukrainian Appeal

Ukraine is facing one of the severest air attacks it has been subjected to since Russia's full-scale invasion on 24th February 2022. Peaceful Ukrainian cities have been hit with deadly missiles, civilians have been targeted, leaving many without basic necessities. Ukrainians remain resilient, however they know a harsh winter is ahead. For this reason we are asked to donate to the emergency winter appeal, which is run in partnership with caritas Ukraine. The cost of one food parcel, providing enough food for two people for a week will cost approximately £16. Each package will contain the basics. The hope is to raise £160,000 allowing 10,000 food parcels to be delivered to those most in need. If you wish to donate.
