

Evangelii Gaudium, also known as "The Joy of the Gospel" is a 2013 apostolic exhortation created by Pope Francis in his aims to evangelize the modern world. Evangelii gaudium aims to overcome complacency at every level of the church's hierarchy and in the life of every Christian.
