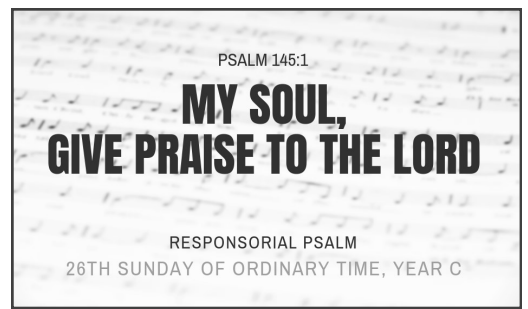

Sign up for First Holy Communion and Confirmation 2023.
