18 - 25 AUGUST 2023

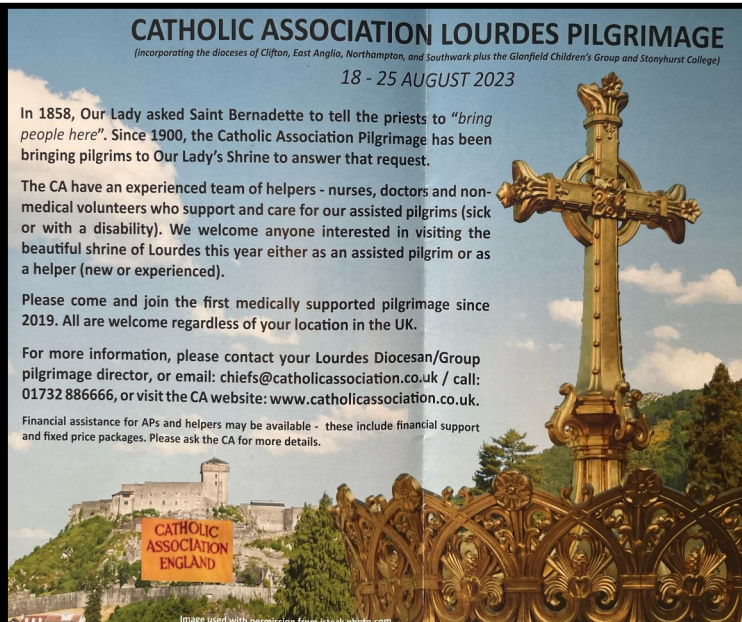
