I surrender Lord, I recognize your Unity of Trinity in my own being.

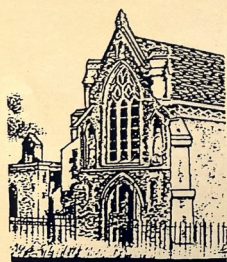
