THE VISIT OF THE RELICS OF ST BERNADETTE TO THE DIOCESE OCTOBER 13 - 16

By inviting us to venerate the mortal remains of the Martyrs and the saints, the Church does not forget that in the end these are indeed just human bones, but they are bones that belonged to individuals touched by the transcendent power of God. Benedict XVI. As you know the relics of St Bernadette arrived in this country earlier this month and have begun to visit the Dioceses of England and Wales. They will be welcomed to the Cathedral on October 13th and by the Church of Our Lady and the English Martyrs on October 15th. There will be Pilgrimages to Norwich and Cambridge. There will be opportunity for Confession during these days and for the sick to be anointed at three special Masses. There will also be talks around the message of Bernadette and the significance of Relics today. And of course an opportunity for prayer and renewal, particularly during the all night Vigils on two of the days. Each day will have a torchlight procession of Our Lady.
