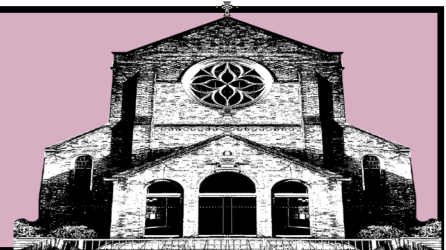

National Cycle of Prayer - World Day of the Poor (33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time)

Next Sunday is the Feast of Christ the King and is celebrated as Youth Day.

Pope Francis has declared Sunday 19 November 2023 to be the seventh World Day of the Poor, with the theme of "Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor". In his message for this World Day of the Poor, Pope Francis reflects on the Book of Tobit, and how it teaches us to be realistic and practical in whatever we do with and for the poor, writing that "caring for the poor is more than simply a matter of a hasty hand-out; it calls for reestablishing the just interpersonal relationships that poverty harms." Pope Francis's letter will be read out at all Masses over the weekend.
