Church Action on Poverty - Sunday 26th February

We will once again have a collection of foodstuffs for the Food Bank at Newmarket Open Door over this weekend. We’d like to try and put ourselves in the shoes of some of those families in our area who need the help of the Food Bank. What must it be like to work really hard and yet still not be able to afford to put a decent meal on the table for your family and to be dependent on the Food Bank? What kind of meals would you want to give your children? What ingredients would help you? We’d suggest items from the following list:

Tinned meat and fish

Tinned and packet soups

Rice, pasta

Jars and packets of pasta sauce

Breakfast cereals

Perhaps the golden rule could be “would I be able to make a meal for my family from this?”
