Gift—Aid "Are you a taxpayer? Currently, 26 parishioners gift-aid their regular offertory donations by making a declaration to HMRC and using identifiable envelopes for their weekly offering on the plate. Another 55 do so through a monthly or weekly standing order from bank to bank. The tax they have all paid on the amounts given is reclaimed for us by the diocese and makes a very significant contribution to the balancing of the parish books. If you are not among them, please reconsider using the scheme. Frank Morgan will provide any information you may need."

CAFOD - if anyone is fundraising in any way or making additional donations to CAFOD during Lent please clearly mark CAFOD so that we can make sure we get the government's matching funding.
