Guttering Works forging ahead! In spite of the various challenges of the weather, the relining of all the 'Finlock' concrete gutters is proceeding very well. The next phase will involve a large crane which will lift the large forming machine up to the high level so that a continuous length of aluminium gutter liner can be fitted to the high roof gutters.

We are also going to be doing some work on areas where the brickwork has 'spalled', i.e. the outer face of the brick has broken off due to frost damage. Some bricks will be cut out and replaced entirely and there will be some necessary re-pointing etc. The root cause of the damage is the lack of an effective 'drip' at the under ends of the parapet coping stones, and this is going to be remedied by the insertion of an 'L-shaped' piece of metal the length of the coping that will make the drip more effective and should reduce the rain penetration of the bricks under the copings.

I hope I will leave Fr. **Christopher** with a church in excellent repair even if there is nothing left in the parish piggy bank!
