REMEMBRANCE 1918 – 2018

The season of Remembrance provides an opportunity for us to remember in order that we do all we can to prevent wars.

As Remembrance Day approaches we will once again have White poppies available at both Churches next weekend.

The wearing of the white poppy is in no way intended to dishonour those who lost their lives in the two World Wars and the many other conflicts ever since. It is a symbol of desire to find an alternative resolution to conflict. History has demonstrated time and again that war rarely resolves conflict and usually leads to division, hatred and violence and ultimately more war. So it is perfectly compatible to wear both a red and a white poppy showing respect for those killed in conflict and, at the same time, a desire to avoid war.

So in this year of 2018 as we mark the end of the First World War let us all wear our white poppies with hope that the world can become a place of peace, love and respect for all God's children.
