THE YOUTH ALPHA GROUP NEED YOUR HELP.

We have recently started a 'Youth Alpha' group in our church – for young people to share time together and learn more about the Christian faith. We have had an amazing response so far and have had 12-14 young people attend for the past 3 weeks.

We meet every Tuesday in the bar from 7:30 – 9pm and play games, share news, watch interactive 'alpha' videos and discuss what being a Christian is all about. New members are always welcome – so if you know a young person who may wish to come along then please let them know. They are very welcome to just turn up. The group is for children in Yr 9 and above. When the Alpha Course ends (about 12 weeks) we will then be continuing with 'Confirmation' sessions for any of the group that may wish to explore further.

Part of this group 'sharing' involves food – and at our first session we were busy making and tossing pancakes – which was very messy and great fun.

So, 3 weeks in - we would like to ask if our lovely parishioners might be able to help us with this part of the evening?

If you are an amazing cake baker maybe you could donate a cake? Or if you are less skilled in the kitchen but super organised with the shopping maybe you could add another pack of something into your basket? We would be very grateful for any donation - savoury or sweet. Things like cakes, crisps, bread sticks, scones, (picnic food) would all be perfect.

We will have a labelled box in the Narthex for non-perishable donations – but if you are thinking that you may be able to offer a wonderful homemade creation – could they please be handed in at the Parish Office (or put in the kitchen) – but only on a Tuesday, please.
