THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (CONFESSIONS)

Confessions will be heard as usual on **Saturday after the 10am Mass and on Saturday evening from 5.30pm until 5.50pm**. Following guidelines from the Bishops, the confessional/reconciliation room will not be used. Confessions will be heard in the **committee room in the parish centre**.

Mass books— In the absence of Mass books, and for those people who do not have their own missal to bring to Mass, there is an App which you can download from Universalis Mass Readings UK. It is a one-off payment of approx. £10. This will give you the Order of Mass, the Mass readings for Sundays and weekdays, and the Divine office (Prayer of the Church).

You can then have this on your phone or tablet to follow during Mass.

A short commentary is given on the first two readings and then there is a meditation on the Gospel.

Stewarding at Mass - if you would like to join the rota of stewarding at week-end Masses, please contact the parish office, 01638 662492.

There will be a rota for stewarding, which means you will not have to commit yourself to every weekend.
