## **THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION (CONFESSIONS)**

Confessions will be heard as usual on **Saturday after the 10am Mass and on Saturday evening from 5.30pm until 5.50pm**. Following guidelines from the Bishops, the confessional/reconciliation room will not be used. Confessions will be heard in the **committee room in the parish centre**.

**Mass books**— In the absence of Mass books, and for those people who do not have their own missal to bring to Mass, there is an App which you can download from Universalis Mass Readings UK. It is a one-off payment of approx. £10. This will give you the Order of Mass, the Mass readings for Sundays and weekdays, and the Divine office (Prayer of the Church).

You can then have this on your phone or tablet to follow during Mass.

A short commentary is given on the first two readings and then there is a meditation on the Gospel.

**Office hours**— The parish office will be open on Monday and Wednesday mornings only, **09.30 –12.30**. Please ring the office for an appointment, if you need to come to the office outside of these hours. Thank you.

**Stewarding at Mass** - if you would like to join the rota of stewarding at weekend Masses, please contact the parish office, 01638 662492.

There will be a rota for stewarding, which means you will not have to commit yourself to every weekend.

Many thanks to the stewards who are currently doing an excellent job of looking after every parishioner as they arrive for Mass.

In order to facilitate the seating of all parishioners in good time before Mass begins, it would be great, if it is possible, for parishioners to arrive at Mass as early as possible, at least 10 or 15 mts before the start of Mass.

This is particularly important if you have booked your seats late, as the allocation of your seat will not be in place, and stewards will need to arrange that for you, therefore a possible delay in signing everyone in .
