THURSDAY PRAYER GROUP

We are now running a new series of sessions praying for Peace – peace in the world, peace in our own land, peace in our own families and in our own lives. We will focus on material produced by *Pax Christi* (the international Catholic agency for peace, justice and reconciliation). They commissioned a beautiful icon from a community near Jerusalem and each week we will explore a different panel of this icon – the first

of which, for example, is of Jacob and Esau, the twin sons of Isaac and Rebekah, focusing on the conflict that ensued between their descendant nations following Jacob's deception of their aged and blind father, Isaac, in order to receive Esau's birthright/blessing from Isaac. We will explore our own reactions to the icon and how it helps us to see how conflict spreads and how it can be resolved and healed; and that will us prayer focus.

This will run for another six weeks in combination with Holy Hours on 1 October and 5 November. Join us if you can.

We are very pleased to be reaching capacity at the 6pm and 10.30am Mass, therefore it is very important to secure your seats for these two Masses in particular, as we do want to ensure we can accommodate all. You might wish to consider coming to the 9am Mass, if you have difficulties booking a seat for either of these Masses. It is also helpful, for seat allocation purposes, if you are booking a family seat, to specify how many are in your family. Try to arrive at church at least **10 minutes** before Mass is due to start. As always, face coverings must be worn whilst in Church, and that social distancing must be observed in Church and in the car park.
