Extracts from Fratelli Tutti— Pope Francis’ teaching letter.

Fratelli Tutti. With these words St. Francis of Assisi addressed his brothers and sisters and proposed to them a way of life marked by the flavour of the Gospel. Of the counsels Francis offered, I would like to select the one which calls for a love that transcends the barriers of geography and distance, and declares blessed all those who love their brother or sister, “as much when he is far away from him as when he is with him.” In this simple and direct way, St. Francis expresses the essence of a fraternal openness that allows us to acknowledge, appreciate and love each person.
