Pope Francis has booked his Covid-19 vaccination and is calling on everyone to receive their jab as an ethical obligation to protect their own health and those around them. *“I believe that, ethically, everyone must take the vaccine”* he said on Italian television. *“It is an ethical choice because you are risking your own health, your life and also risking the lives of others”*.
