Financial speculation fundamentally aimed at quick profit continues to wreck havoc. Indeed, "without internal forms of solidarity and mutual trust, the market cannot completely fulfil its proper economic function. And today this trust has ceased to exist". The story did not end the way it was meant to, and the dogmatic formulae of prevailing economic theory proved not to be infallible. The fragility of world systems in the face of the pandemic has demonstrated that not everything can be resolved by market freedom. It has also shown that, in addition to recovering a sound political life that is not subject to the dictates of finance, "we must put human dignity back at the centre and on the pillar build the alternative social structures we need".

- ◆ Holy Communion will start to be given under one kind only. The Priest/Deacon/Minister will say to each communicant, "The Body of Christ" to which they reply "Amen".
- ◆ Communion may now be given on the tongue. If you wish to receive communion in this way, please come to communion last.
- ◆ There will be no congregational singing for the moment. Hopefully by the 22nd June we may be able to sing.
