Fr Leo was a Sri Lankan Jesuit Priest. He studied theology at Heythrop College (2005-2009) London and trained as a psycho-dynamic psychotherapist in Westminster Pastoral foundation (WPF Therapy London). He also worked as an assistant priest at St Anselm's Church, Southall, London. He did social work and Ignatian retreat apostolate in Sri Lanka. In 2018 he moved to the United Kingdom again and was incardinated into the Diocese of East Anglia as Diocesan priest. He was the Catholic chaplain at Norwich Norfolk University Hospital (NNUH) and Assistant Priest in the St John the Baptist Cathedral, Norwich. He is to be installed as Parish Priest at O.L.I.S.E on 3rd October by Bishop Alan Hopes.
