From the Pastoral Team

We have introduced Hymn Books at Sunday Masses in Newmarket. We still keep our masks on and it is a sign that we are returning to a (new) normal! We will continue to see how we can return to the fulness of our worship while maintaining a prudent concern for our safety from the virus. From Sunday 17 October there will be tea, coffee and soft drink after the 1030 Mass. We will have to introduce the sort of safeguards that are common to cafes and restaurants but we think that we can meet safely within those limits.

Parish Forum : We are planning to hold an open Parish Forum to review where we are as a parish and to consider how best to witness to our faith, in the Hall after the 1030 Mass on Sunday 28 November (the Feast of Christ the King). Hold the date!

First Communion : Those children who had completed most of the first communion programme before lockdown will resume their prayerful studies and will be receiving first communion during Advent and in time for Christmas. A new programme will start at the beginning of the new year. Please register any boys or girls for the new programme before 1 November. First Holy communion classes for children signing up now starting in January and finish in May 2022. Confirmations: We need to begin a confirmation programme for anyone over the age of 14 and we really need volunteers to be trained to assist in the preparation of the candidates. Readers : We hope to have a 'Quiet Day' and refresher programme during Advent. There will also be a day for Lay Ministers of Holy Communion once we are able to offer communion from the chalice again.

Justice and Peace : Our wonderful J&P group collapsed on the eve of lockdown with key members retiring away from the parish. We would love to get it up and running again and to launch some new parish projects. We have so much surely to want to share with those who have little or who are experiencing persecution. Christmas Day will be on a Saturday, so it will be quite a challenge to see if Sunday observance will be followed on Sunday 26 December!
