### SYONDAL

The Catholic Church this weekend officially begins preparations for the next ordinary assembly of the Synod of The Bishops, which will take place in October 2023 in Rome. The Acts of the Apostles tell that when the early Christian communities needed to resolve certain practical problems or pastoral questions, they held an assembly of believers, called on the Holy Spirit and discussed with those in authority. Therefore Bishop has asked us to pray Adsumus Sancte Spiritus Prayer regularly after the post communion collect. This prayer was used at every session of the Second Vatican Council.

*We stand before You, Holy Spirit,  
as we gather together in Your name.  
With You alone to guide us,  
make Yourself at home in our hearts;  
Teach us the way we must go  
and how we are to pursue it.  
We are weak and sinful;  
do not let us promote disorder.  
Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path  
nor partiality influence our actions.  
Let us find in You our unity  
so that we may journey together to eternal life  
and not stray from the way of truth  
and what is right.  
All this we ask of You,  
who are at work in every place and time,  
in the communion of the Father and the Son,  
forever and ever. Amen.*
